## **+ LEISURE COURSES**

You can take English classes in the morning, (15 hours per week), and combine them with + courses in the afternoon.

All the courses are taught by suitably qualified teachers and coaches on a one to one basis.

### **Afternoon Tea**

Learn about different kinds of tea - sample a traditional 'cream' tea in a local tea-shop or hotel and prepare a traditional cream tea with a cookery teacher.

### **Aromatherapy**

The course takes place at a nearby clinic. You learn about mixing and using essential oils for home and personal use.

### **Art**

Learn about drawing, still life, landscapes, abstract and ceramic art. For beginners or more experienced artists. Please specify whether you wish to study watercolour or oil paints.

### **Beauty Therapy**

Lessons taught nearby. Learn about make-up techniques, skin care, nail design, beauty treatments and body grooming.

### **Cake Decorating**

Learn about icing, uses of marzipan, making sugar flowers, writing in icing, modelling and professional techniques. The course takes place nearby.

### **Calligraphy**

Learn to write beautifully and about the history, as well as techniques, of writing. From beginners to advanced calligraphers.

### **Cookery**

Learn English and Continental cookery – and eat or take your work home!

### **Dancing**

Choose from tap, ballet, ballroom (waltz, tango, foxtrot, quickstep), or Latin American (jive, samba, rumba, paso doble, salsa, cha-cha). From beginners to more experienced dancers.
